1. Introduction

This is an encrypted wireless network for guests. It is the recommended wireless network for anyone who does not have an account in the Commnet or CSU domains. You will need to request access for login credentials from your [local IT department](#).

You will need a wireless device which supports WPA2 in order to connect to this network, and you will have to configure a wireless connection (see details below for platform specific information) before you can connect.

2. Connecting to the ConnSCU Guests Wireless Network

Step 1 - View available wireless networks via configured wireless utility (in this case, utilizing Windows' native wireless utility) – click on the wireless 'bars' icon in system tray:

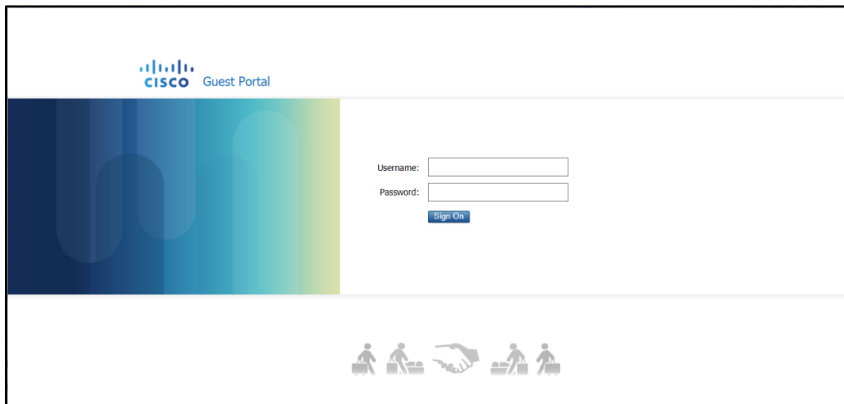




Step 2 - Click on 'ConnSCU Guests' in the list and choose 'Connect'

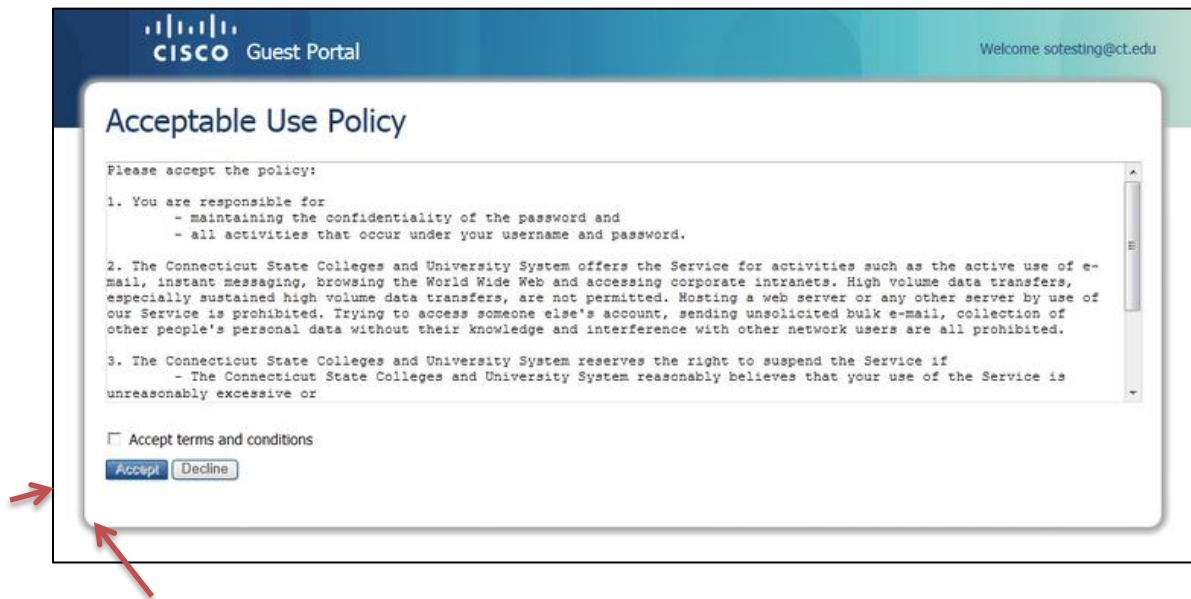


Step 3 – Open a browser and you will be redirected to the ConnSCU Guests portal:

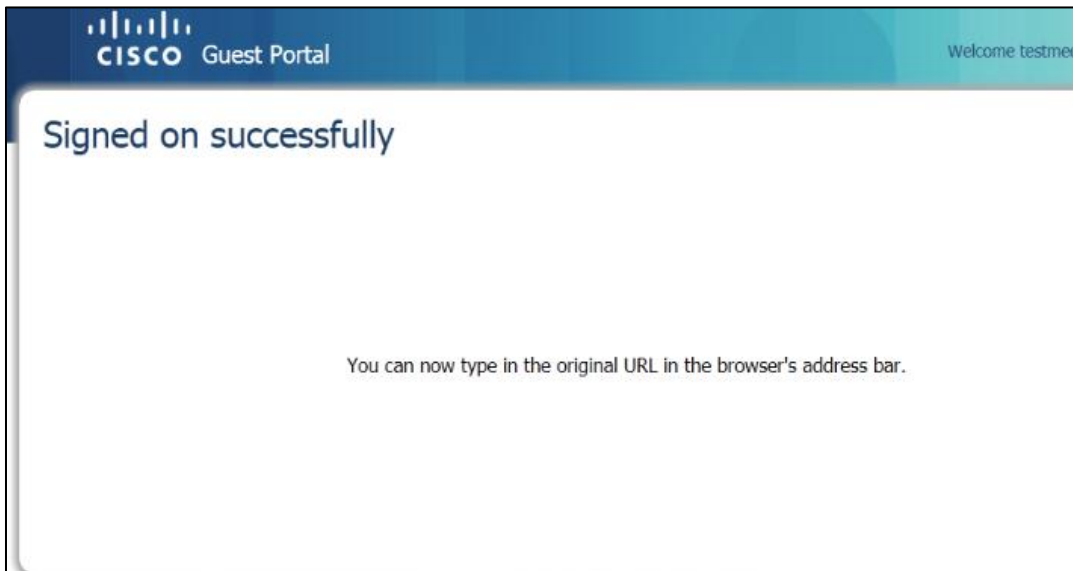


Login with the username and password provided when you requested access and press 'Login'

Step 4 – You'll then be presented with the screen to accept the User Policy. If, after reading the policy, you agree to the Acceptable Use Policy conditions, check the box for **Accept terms and conditions** and press **Accept**:



Step 5 – The screen below should appear to confirm the connection after accepting the user policy agreement. Open a new tab and browse away.
