

## Accessing ConnSCU Wireless from Macs

(Revision Date: 7/28/2016)

### Introduction

This is an encrypted network for students, faculty and staff. It is the recommended wireless network for anyone with a ConnSCU NetID.

You will need a wireless device which supports WPA2 in order to connect to this network, and you will have to configure a wireless connection (see details below for platform specific information) before you can connect. Once configured, most clients will be able to reconnect automatically rather than having to re-enter your credentials.

### Connecting to ConnSCU Wireless network

**Step 1** - Click on the wireless icon in top menu to access wireless settings:




**Step 2** – From the list of available wireless networks, select 'ConnSCU':



**Step 3** – You will be prompted to enter your login credentials. Insert your information, then click 'OK':
