

## Accessing ConnSCU Wireless from iPad/iPhone

### Introduction

This is an encrypted network for students, faculty and staff. It is the recommended wireless network for anyone with a ConnSCU NetID.

You will need a wireless device which supports WPA2 in order to connect to this network, and you will have to configure a wireless connection (see details below for platform specific information) before you can connect. Once configured, most clients will be able to reconnect automatically rather than having to re-enter your credentials.

### Connecting to the ConnSCU Internet Wireless Network

**Step 1** – Access ‘Settings’  your iPad/iPhone and select ‘Wi-Fi’ as shown below:



**Step 2** – Ensure the ‘Wi-Fi’ slider is set to ‘On’. Select “ConnSCU” from the list of available wireless networks.

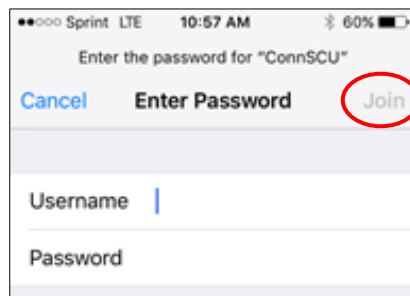


**Step 3** – You will be prompted to enter your login credentials. Insert your information, then click ‘Join’:

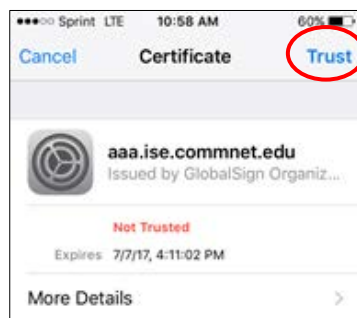
- For Community College and BOR System Office users, login with your [NetID](#) and password. E.g:
