

Connecting to ConnSCU – MacOSX

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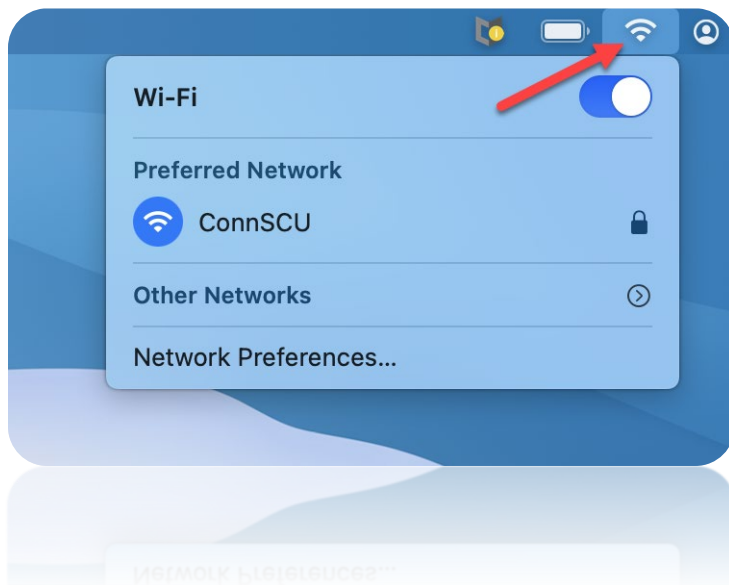
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Introduction

This is an encrypted network for students, faculty, and staff. It is the recommended network for anyone with a ConnSCU NetID. You will need a wireless device which supports WPA2 in order to connect to the network and you will have to configure a wireless connection before you can connect. Once configured, clients will be able to reconnect automatically, rather than re-entering your credentials every instance.

1. Finding ConnSCU on MacOSX

Step 1 – Open up your Wi-Fi settings in the top-right hand corner:

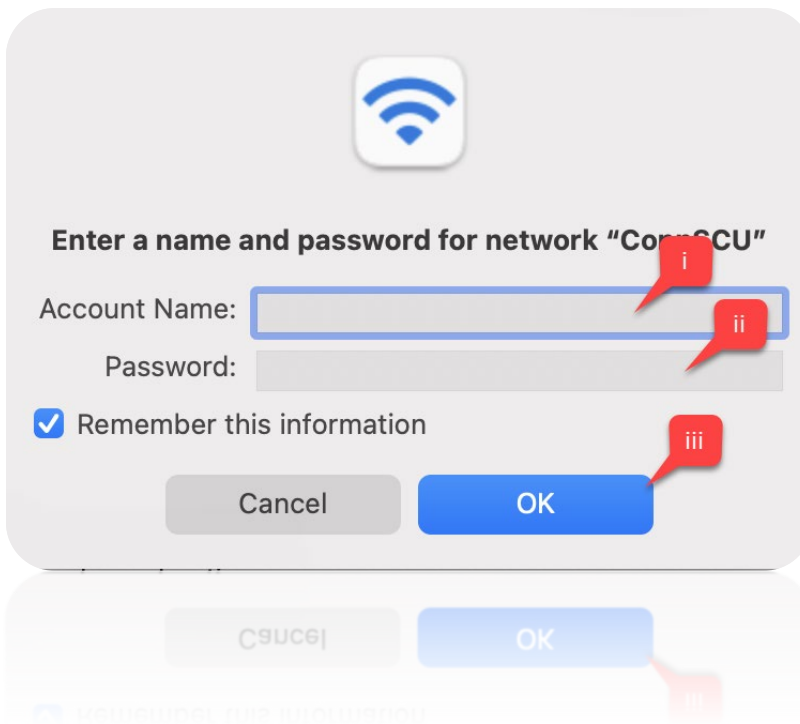


Step 2 – From the available networks, select ‘ConnSCU’:



2. Configuring Your Connection to ConnSCU

Step 1 – You should then be prompted for your NetID and password:

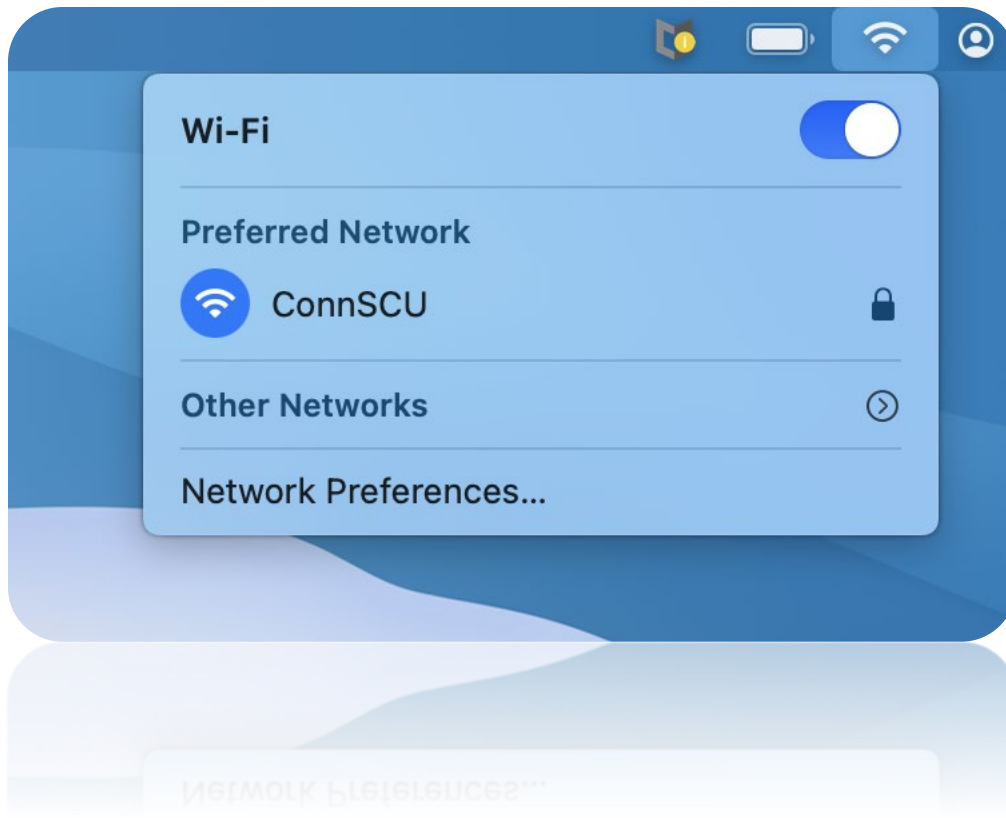


i. ‘Account Name’ – Enter your full NetID:

01234567@student.commnet.edu

ii. ‘Password’ – Enter your password (the password used to sign into myCommNet)

iii. Click ‘OK’ when you have put in the correct credentials



You should now be logged in and connected to the network!
