

# Connecting to ConnSCU – Windows 10

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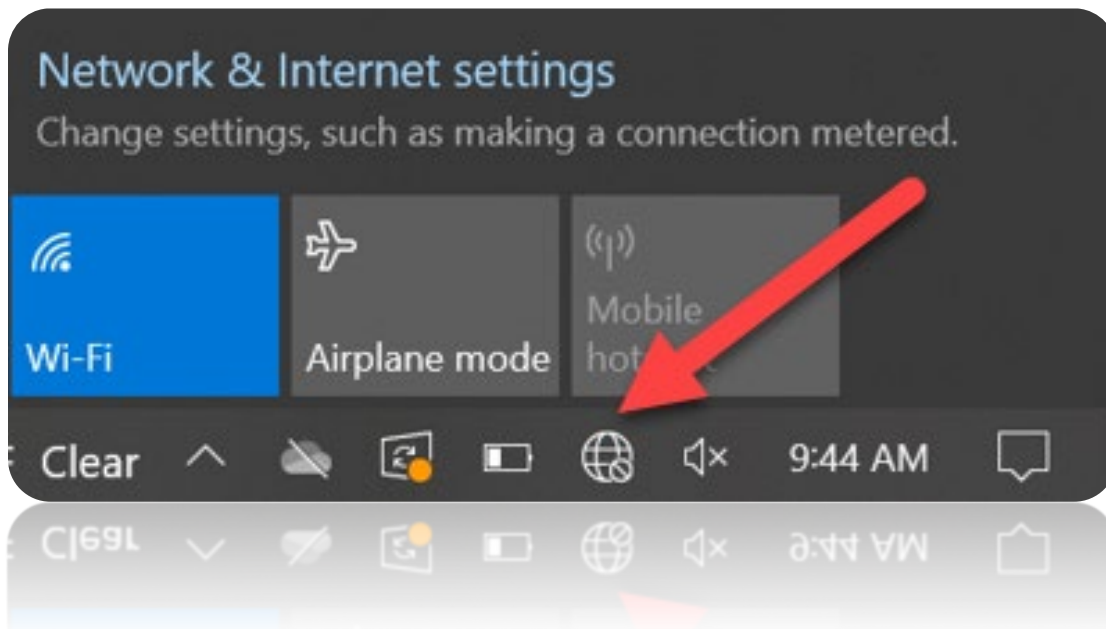
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## Introduction

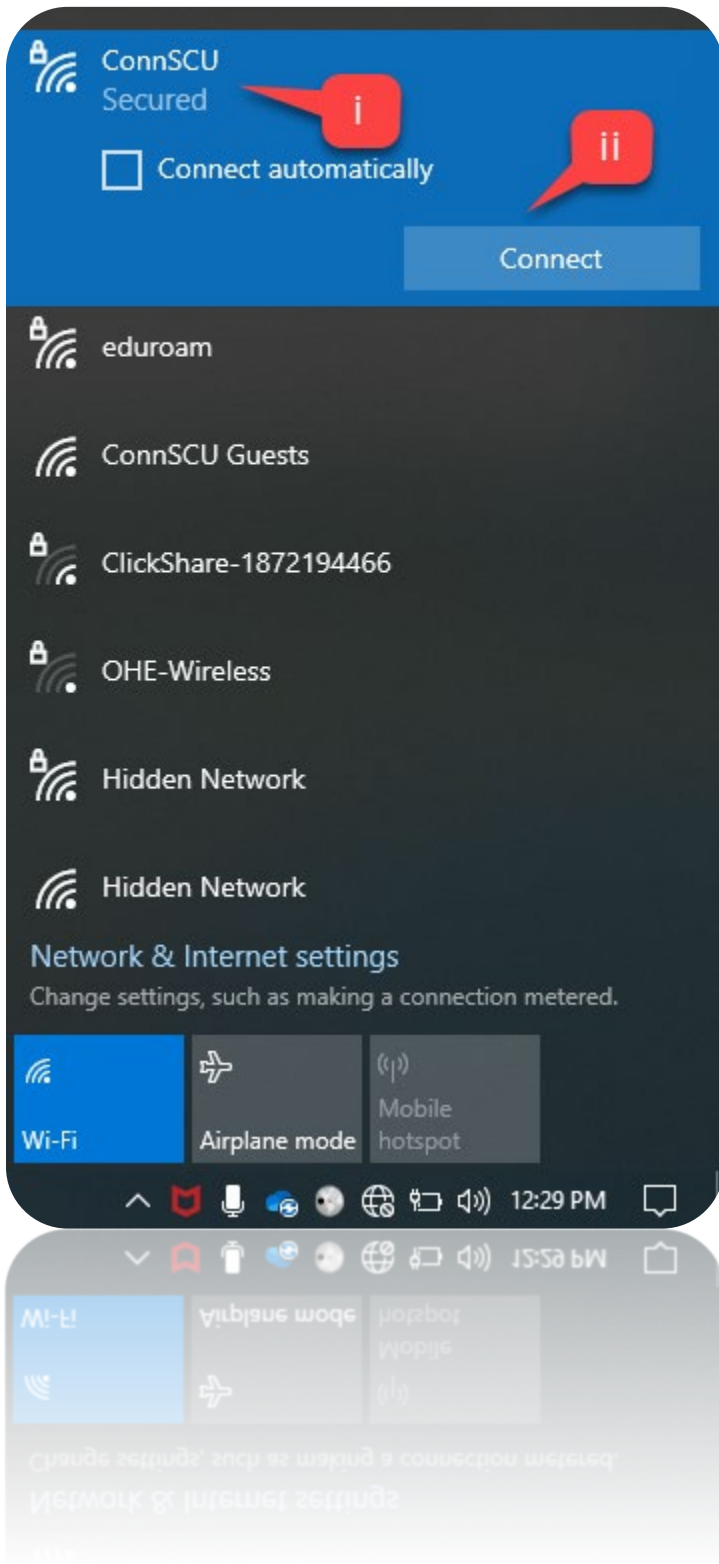
This is an encrypted network for students, faculty, and staff. It is the recommended network for anyone with a ConnSCU NetID. You will need a wireless device which supports WPA2 in order to connect to the network and you will have to configure a wireless connection before you can connect. Once configured, clients will be able to reconnect automatically, rather than re-entering your credentials every instance.

### 1. Finding ConnSCU on Windows 10

**Step 1** – Open up your network by clicking on the ‘globe’ icon on the right of your taskbar:

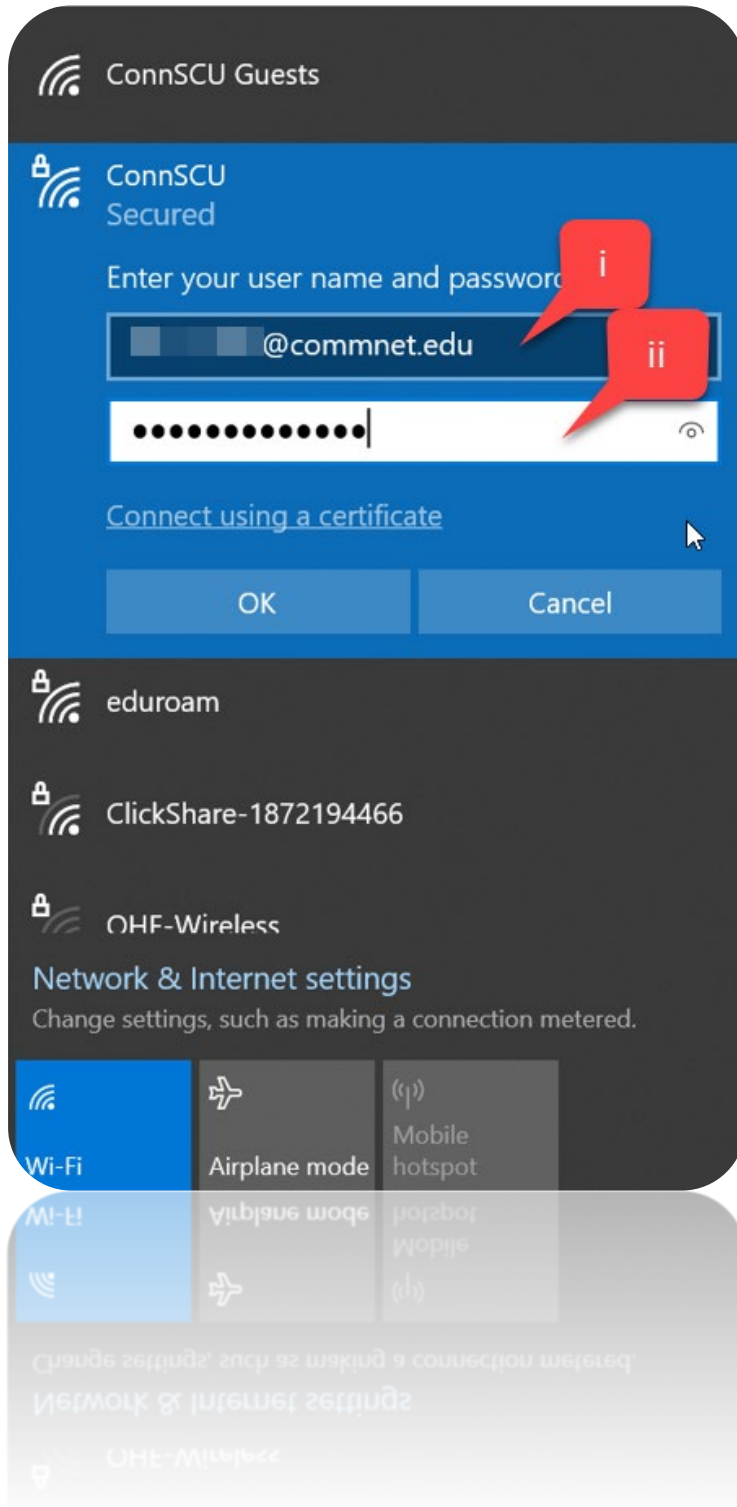


**Step 2** – From the available networks, select ‘ConnSCU’:



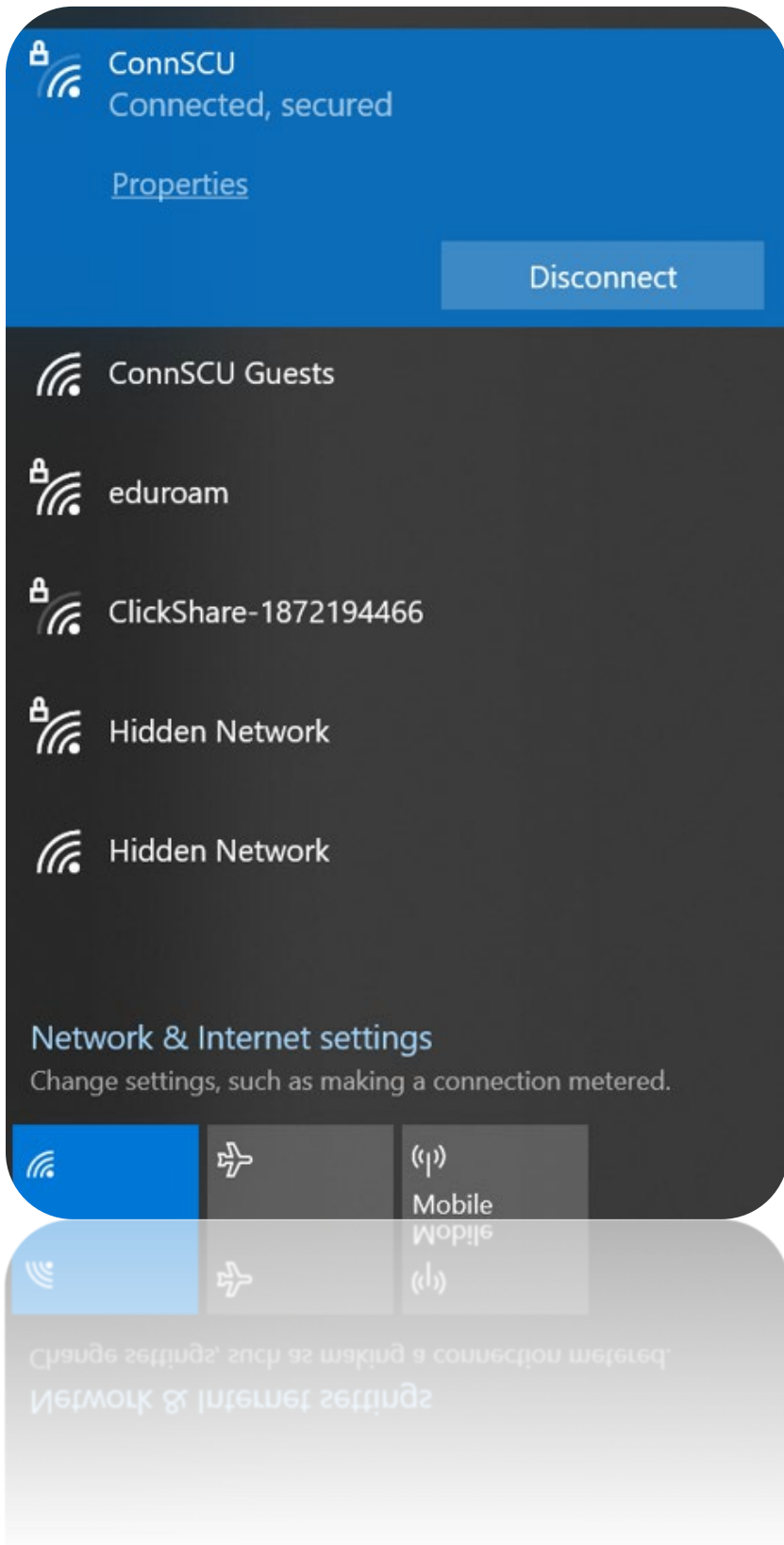
## 2. Configuring Your Connection to ConnSCU

**Step 1** – You should be prompted to enter your NetID and password:



- i. Enter your full NetID  
(ex. 01234567@student.commnnet.edu)
- ii. Enter your password (the password  
used to log into myCommNet)

All set! You will now be connected to the network ConnSCU.
