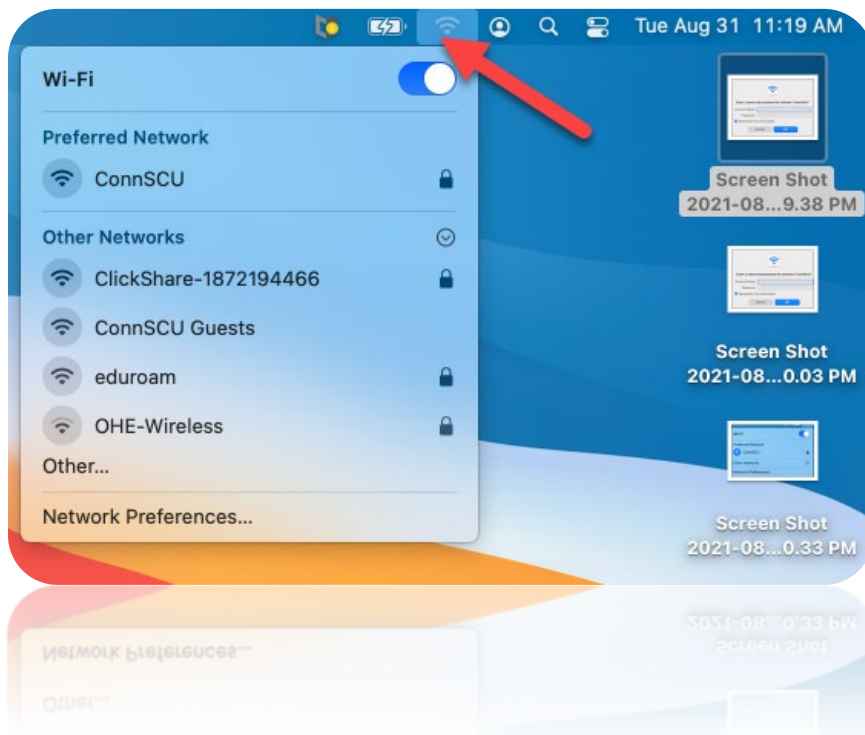

Introduction

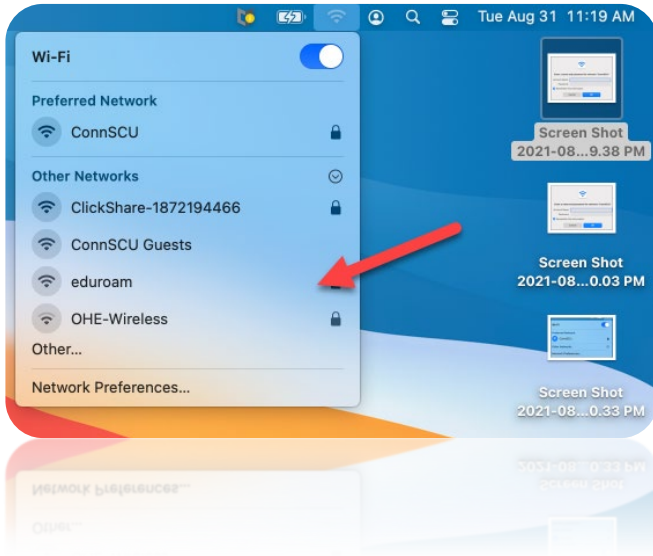
This is an encrypted network for students, faculty, and staff. It is the recommended network for anyone with a ConnSCU NetID. You will need a wireless device which supports WPA2 in order to connect to the network and you will have to configure a wireless connection before you can connect. Once configured, clients will be able to reconnect automatically, rather than re-entering your credentials every instance.

1. Finding eduroam on MacOS

Step 1 – Open up your Wi-Fi settings in the top-right hand corner:

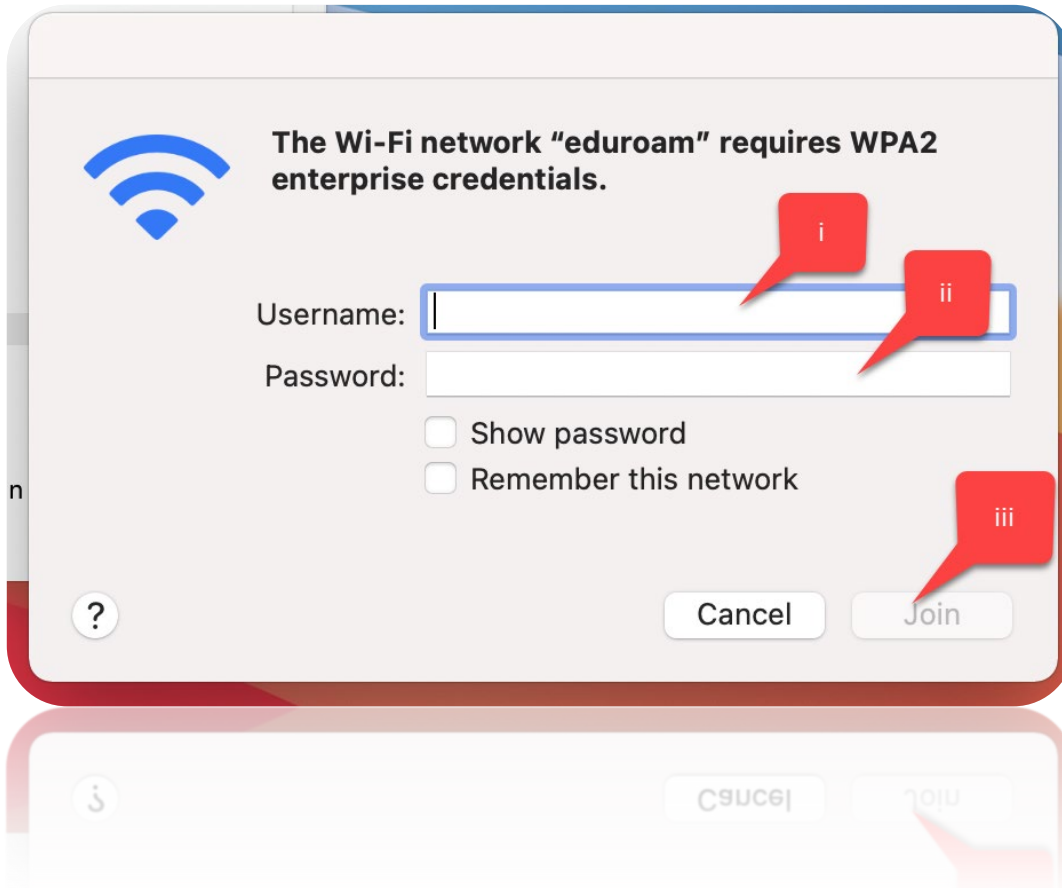


Step 2 – From the available networks, select ‘eduroam’:



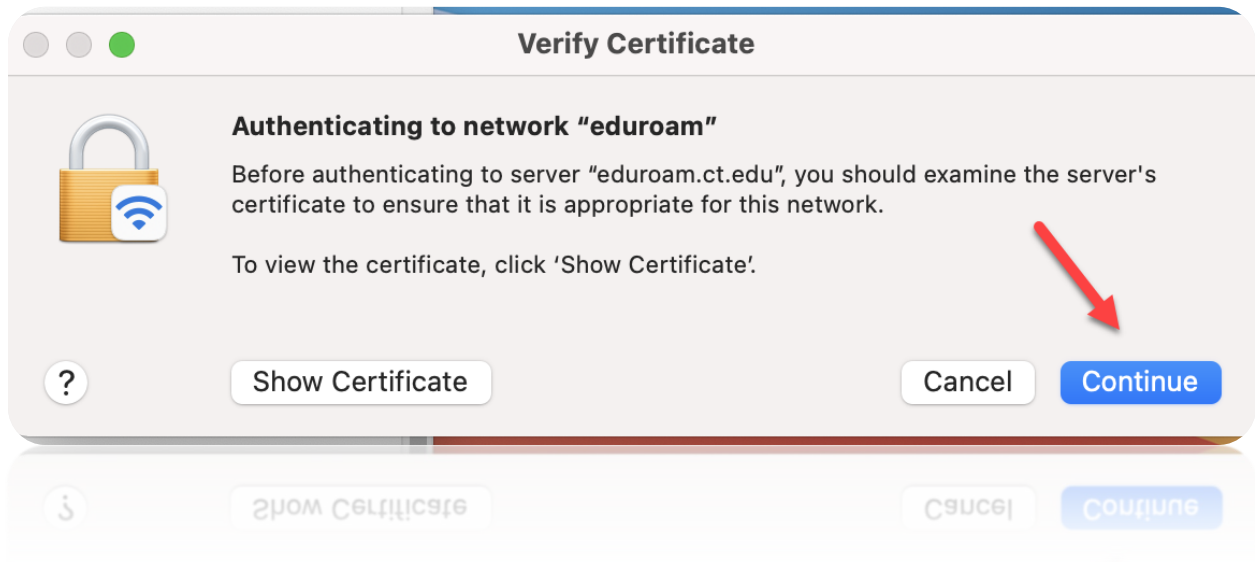
2. Configuring Your Connection to eduroam

Step 1 – You should then be prompted for your NetID (ex. 01234567@student.comnet.edu) and a password (the password used to log into myCommNet):



- i. Enter your full NetID
- ii. Enter your password
- iii. Click 'Join' to enter the network

Step 2 – Authenticate to the eduroam server by clicking on ‘Continue’:



You should now be logged in and connected to the network!
